Pennsylvanians without prescription drug coverage can get discounted drugs thanks to a new program sponsored by pharmaceutical companies.

The program, Together Rx Access, provides participants with 25 percent to 40 percent discounts on more than 275 prescriptions. The prescriptions can be filled at 90 percent of the pharmacies in Pennsylvania.

Only legal U.S. residents who are not eligible for Medicare and don't have public or private prescription drug coverage are eligible. Additionally, individuals can't make more than \$30,000, and families of four can't earn more than \$60,000 to be eligible.

The year-old national program has already enrolled 400,000 people.
