Going to Bat for America's Uninsured

Scranton, PA, June 10, 2006, – Scranton-Wilkes Barre baseball fans attending the Red Barons Game on June 10 will have a lot to cheer about. Representatives from Together Rx Access™ will be onsite at Lackawanna Stadium throughout the game to talk to individuals about how to save on their prescription medications.

The Together Rx Access Card was created by 10 pharmaceutical companies to help hardworking Americans and their families gain access to meaningful savings on prescriptions right at the pharmacy counter. Most cardholders save 25 percent to 40 percent* on brand-name prescription products, including medicines to treat high cholesterol, diabetes, asthma, and many other conditions. Over 300 brand-name prescription products[†] are included in the program. Savings are also available on a range of generic products. The Together Rx Access Card is accepted at the majority of pharmacies nationwide and in Puerto Rico. The Card is free to get, and free to use.

As the sponsor of the Red Barons Game on June 10, representatives from Together Rx Access will be located throughout the concourse at Lackawanna Stadium to help fans determine if they qualify for the program. Those who are eligible can be enrolled immediately. To qualify for the Together Rx Access Card, applicants cannot be eligible for Medicare, or have public or private prescription drug coverage. They cannot have a household income of more than \$30,000 for a single person or \$60,000 for a family of four (income eligibility is adjusted for family size). And they must be a legal resident of the United States or Puerto Rico.
